FRUIT SALSA

Adapted from recipe by Cooking Matters

Ingredients:

- 2 mangoes, 1 pineapple or 4 peaches
- 1 small cucumber
- 2 medium green onions
- 1 medium red bell pepper
- 2 medium limes

Optional ingredients:

- 1 medium jalapeno
- 1/4 cup fresh cilantro
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- Pinch of cayenne pepper



Instructions:

- 1. Rinse all fresh ingredients. If using canned fruit, drain.
- 2. Peel skin from fruit and cucumber if desired, then dice.
- 3. Cut bell pepper in half, remove stem and seeds, then dice. Repeat with jalapeno, if using.
- 4. Finely chop green onions, as well as cilantro if using.
- 5. Add everything to a bowl. Add juice from 2 limes. Mix well.

Chef's Notes

- Try it with other seasonal fruits such as watermelon, cantaloupe, cherries, plums or apples. Try to use ripe but still firm fruit so your salsa isn't too mushy.
- Cover and refrigerate for better flavor, for 2 hours up to overnight. Store in refrigerator for up to 3 days.
- Ways to enjoy: Serve with tortilla chips; use as a topping for tacos or grilled meat or fish; add to salads, grain bowls, quesadillas, burritos or wraps.
